John F. Kennedy International Airport is one of the busiest international airports in the world. Located in the Queens district of New York City, JFK International Airport handles (1) ... international passengers than any other airport in the United States. In 2010 over 46 million passengers went (2) the terminals of JFK.

The airport is a city in itself. More than 90 airlines (3) ... in and out of New York's JFK airport. The busiest routes from JFK lead to London, Madrid and Paris.

The airport opened in 1948. Originally, it was called Idlewild Airport. It was (4) shortly after President Kennedy was assassinated in 1963.

Currently there are four runways on (5) ... planes take off and land. One of them is long enough for a space shuttle to land.

JFK airport has eight terminals with a total of over 150 gates. All the terminals are connected with each other through a train system. This train system connects the airport with downtown New York. It takes passengers about 30 to 40 minutes (6) ... to Central Manhattan, about 20 km from the airport.

Most of the cargo between Europe and the United States passes through JFK and almost a quarter of all international (7) to and from the USA are handled by the airport.

JFK International Airport has also been the location of several accidents and tragedies. Among (8) ... a TWA flight exploded shortly after taking off from JFK. All 230 people were killed. In April 2011 an Airbus A-380 crashed into a smaller plane (9) ... still on the ground. Fortunately (10) was injured.
